### Key map 9a: centre circle Swedish/Finnish Shift-Confirm keys

This map applies when your Lomak is set to the Swedish/Finnish layout.

### Key map 11: centre circle Norwegian Shift-Confirm keys

This map applies when your Lomak is set to the Norwegian layout.

Up to v4.2, the Norwegian keys allocated to C and E in the above table were placed on the B and C keys.

## Dead keys

Dead keys are keys that do not create characters immediately, but modify the next key (if allowed) by adding an accent mark to it. The Scandinavian layouts have five dead keys on the Control bar on Options 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 which are used as described in the section *The dead keys on the Control bar* in the page *Creating international keys* in the User Guides. This is an easy method of creating accented characters.

Accent	Option key (from v4.3)	Standard dead key sequence (all revisions except where noted)
tilde (ã)	1	Shift-Back tick (~) in the left circle
umlaut (ä)	2	Shift-Confirm-o-Confirm (up to v4.2 only)
acute (á)	3	Shift-Confirm-n-Confirm (up to v4.2 only)

circumflex (â)	4	<b>Shift-6-Confirm</b> (^) in the right circle
grave (à)	5	<b>Back tick</b> (') in the left circle

## AltGr keys

The **Right Alt** (or **AltGr**) key can be used to create the following characters:

Character required	AltGr combination	Comment
@	<b>AltGr-2</b>	Also <b>Shift-2</b>
£	<b>AltGr-3</b>	
\$	<b>AltGr-4</b>	Also <b>Shift-4</b>
€	<b>AltGr-5</b> or <b>AltGr-E</b>	
µ	<b>AltGr-M</b>	
{ and }	<b>AltGr-7</b> and <b>AltGr-0</b> , respectively	Also on left circle
[ and ]	<b>AltGr-8</b> and <b>AltGr-9</b> , respectively	Also on left circle
